ASIA-PACIFIC MARKET OUTLOOK

Intelligent buildings are springing up around Asia-Pacific region, with a forecast size of US\$1,036 billion by 2020, of which one-third will be contained by the world's largest market for intelligent buildings – China. Eco friendly buildings have become a major focal point of the construction industry in China owing to the PRC government's emphasis on "Green development, the construction of a resource-saving and eco-friendly society" in the 12th Five-year plan. It is believed that China's market for green technology will surge to US\$239 billion by 2020.

CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY FLOURISHING IN HONG KONG AND MACAO

In Hong Kong, large scale expansion projects are planned and expected to create immense opportunities among the construction and design industries, as well as incorporating green initiatives. New commercial developments in at least seven areas in Kowloon East might have to get green building certification and provide space for artists, turning the areas into a low-carbon emission community. Key infrastructure projects such as Kai Tak Development costing HK\$64.2 billion and West Kowloon Cultural District with an endowment fund of HK\$21.6 billion are concurrently under construction and will come into operation between 2014 and 2015. Major transport initiatives are also being taken forward in full swing, including a 30km road bridge across the Pearl River Delta linking Hong Kong, Macao and Zhuhai at an estimated cost of \$57.4 billion for completion in 2016 and five railway projects for completion between 2014 and 2020 totaling HK\$180.1 billion.



While in Macao, the Cotai Strip has been a significant land reclamation project ever since its opening in 2006 with resorts, theme parks and most importantly casinos being constructed over the past years. Seeing substantial revenue and high business potential, numerous entertainment groups and hotel developers have already announced further extensive investment in the near future.




